School planning for 2023-24

- Jonathan to undertake Oide Leading Digital Learning Training as part of our School Self Evaluation Plan (SSE). This is the starting point of creating a Digital Learning School Plan.
- Claire and Lynn are beginning the process of creating our Wellbeing Plan which will be another aspect of our SSE.
- Fiona will look at the strands of the History Curriculum, especially those from 3rd class onwards, to create an accessible guide ensuring a broad range of topics are covered within the curriculum.
- Training will begin this year for the new Primary Maths Curriculum.

Afterschools and Camps

- Dulra Forest School is running for Infants between September 25th and November 6th on our grounds.
- Junior Einsteins having a free tester on September 25th for all ages. This will determine if it goes ahead.

School development and building

- Permanent Extension We are awaiting on a report from our Design Team, QS, and various engineers. This will then be submitted to the Department. Once they sign off on it the school applies for planning permission.
- New Temporary Modular Mainstream Classroom This is now the Ash Room for our 5th/6th class pupils.
- Bicycle and Scooter Shelters have been installed at the front of the school a reminder to drive slowly and carefully in this area.

Finances and Resources

• The Free Book Scheme Grant, funded by the DE, has meant parent-guardians have not been required to purchase schoolbooks and copies.

During the summer, the Board have purchased the following -

- The school was deep cleaned in July.
- IT purchases included five tablets for our Hazel, Birch and SEN Rooms. A Wifi point was
 connected in the new Ash Room. An Interactive Screen was relocated to the Ash Room while
 a new Interactive Screen was purchased for the Oak Room. A new laptop was purchased for
 the Elm Room.
- Furniture was purchased for the Ash Room and other classes.
- New BETNS School Sports Kits, designed by our Student Council, were delivered in September.
